Motion to Compel Response to Request for Production of Documents

The unopposed motion by the plaintiff Reda Beaver for an order compelling defendant Riggs Ambulance Service, Inc. to serve responses to plaintiff's request for production of documents is GRANTED. (Code Civ. Proc., § 2031.300.) Defendant shall serve verified responses, without objection, to plaintiff's Request for Production of Documents, Set Two, within ten days of notice of entry of order.

In accordance with Code of Civil Procedure section 2031.300, subdivision (c), the Court imposes a monetary sanction against defendant Riggs Ambulance Service, Inc. in the amount of \$397.50 due and payable to plaintiff twenty days from notice of entry of order.

The prevailing party is directed to prepare a written order consistent with the Court's ruling for the Court's signature, pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 3.1312, and to provide notice thereof to the opposing party/counsel as required by law and the California Rules of Court. The order is to be submitted by electronic filing to Hon. Thomas P. Breen.
